To set up your page on either of these sites, follow these simple instructions:

1. Go to either website and click on the button to create your page.
2. You will need to have an account to create the page, but this is very quick to set up.
3. Select The Sick Children's Trust as your chosen charity (you may find it easier to search for us by our charity registration number, 284416)
4. You'll then have the opportunity to customise your very own page with pictures and text. Make sure you include a paragraph detailing why you are raising money, so that you can inspire people to give as much as possible.

Once you have set up your page, you can use Facebook, Twitter or just your general email account to send the link round to all your friends and family and ask them to donate.

The money will then be directly transferred into our bank, so all you have to worry about is preparing for your fundraising event!

On Paper

If you are perhaps not so computer savvy or just want to do things the traditional way, we have paper sponsorship forms that you can pass around your friends, family and colleagues.

By approaching people face to face, you will be able to interact with them on a more personal level, and you will have the opportunity to explain fully what we do as a charity, which may even lead to bigger donations!
