Thank you so much for requesting a Sick Children's Trust home collection box, we really appreciate your support. The Sick Children's Trust's collection boxes are to be used in your home to collect spare change which will make a huge difference to the families we support. Please note that if you are organising an event which is happening in a place used by the public such as a supermarket, pub, train station etc. you will need a plastic collection tin as these are sturdy and can be chained down. How to pay in your donation

How to gift aid your donation

Gift Aid enables registered charities to reclaim tax on a donation made by a UK taxpayer, effectively increasing the amount of the donation. To be eligible for gift aid you need to pay tax and you will have to provide your address to identify yourself as a current taxpayer. There is a gift aid declaration form on the collection box which will need to be completed and returned to either a House Manager or Head Office. If you do not want to cut up your box you can request a gift aid form from our Fundraising Team or download it from our website which you can send in with your donation.
