

The Sick Children's Trust Lottery - Terms & Conditions

1. All Lottery applicants and participants must be 16 years of age or over and be resident in the United Kingdom.
2. Once you have completed your form, send it to Lottery Co-ordinator, The Sick Children's Trust, Lower Ground Floor, 88 Leadenhall Street, London, EC3A 3BP. Once we have received and processed your entry form we will send you a letter acknowledging your entry and The SCT Lottery membership card with your unique lottery number. We will also notify you of the date of the first draw in which you are eligible to win.
3. The cost of entry is £1 per month for a minimum of 12 months, which is payable annually by direct debit, or upfront by cheque, cash or credit/debit card. The Sick Children's Trust prefers payments by recurring direct debit, to reduce administration costs whilst being more convenient for you. Payments must be made in advance.
4. The draw will be held on the last Friday of each month and the winning numbers will be selected at random by computer. Winners will be contacted by The Sick Children's Trust and names of winners (title and surname only) will be published on www.sickchildrenstrust.org, displayed in our 'Homes from Home' and in our newsletter.
5. Winners will receive their prize by post. A cheque for the prize value will be sent within 14 days to the player's registered address. It is the player's responsibility to ensure that the details held by The SCT, including address and telephone number, are correct.
6. Winners have up to 6 months to claim their prize by cashing their cheque. If the prize is not claimed within the specified time frame, unclaimed prizes will be donated back to The Sick Children's Trust.
7. Prizes will be listed at www.sickchildrenstrust.org.
8. We reserve the right to use the winners' names for promotional purposes.
9. We cannot accept responsibility for any delays in bank or card payments. Players will be informed of the first draw in which they are eligible to play.
10. We reserve the right to decline an application or cancel an existing subscription without giving reason. We also reserve the right to cancel The SCT Lottery if necessary, in which case refunds will be made of all payments for which a draw has not taken place.
11. The number of entries from one individual is limited to twenty (20).
12. The Sick Children's Trust reserves the right to change or update The SCT Lottery rules to reflect changes in legislation.
13. The promoter's decisions are final.
14. All profits from The SCT Lottery will go to The Sick Children's Trust, helping families with very sick children across the UK.
