

# Donations in Celebration



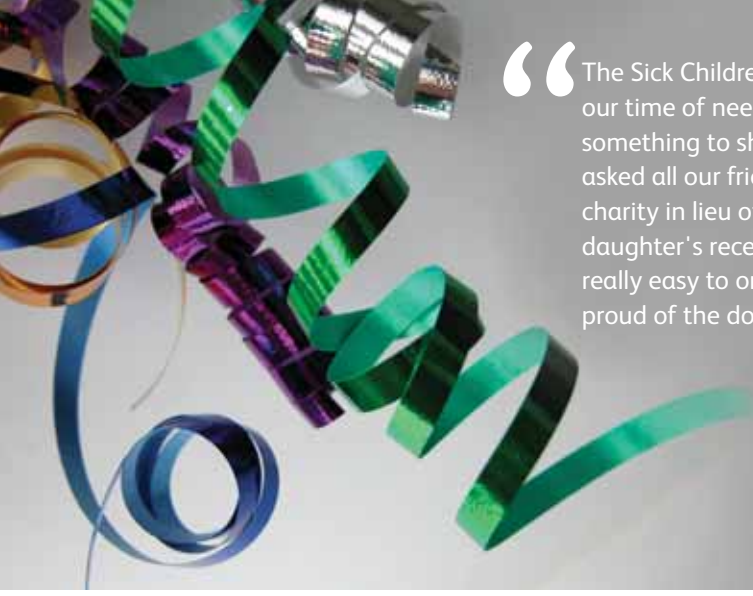
**Making a donation to The Sick Children's Trust in lieu of gifts is a fantastic way to mark a very special occasion.**

## There are many ways you can make a donation in lieu of gifts:

### Online fundraising page
