At Waitrose, we are very much part of the communities we work in, and Waitrose Community Matters is our way of giving something back to the local area.

We do that by donating money to good causes nominated by our customers, and supporting our Partners (Partners because we all share in the business) to do a variety of voluntary work with local organisations.

Each month, every branch donates £1000 to local good causes, divided between three organisations. At the checkout, you'll be given a green token, and on the way out, you'll see

our three Community Matters boxes, one for each of that month's chosen causes. Simply place your token into the box for the cause you'd most like to support, and the money will be divided according to the number of tokens each one receives.

You can also nominate local good causes to be considered for the Community Matters scheme. Just fill in the form overleaf and hand it in at the Welcome Desk.

So far, we've donated over £10m to 30,000 different causes, and the scheme has been given a Big Society award by the Prime Minister, David Cameron.
